Epping St John's Church of England School are celebrating improved GCSE results

Students and staff at Epping St John's Church of England School are celebrating improved GCSE results for the third year running.

In English, 75 per cent of students achieved grade 4 or higher, with 16 per cent collecting the top grades of 7 to 9. Last year, 12 per cent achieved grade 7 to 9 in the subject.

In maths, 64 per cent of students achieved grade 4 or higher, with 17 per cent collecting the top grades of 7 to 9. Last year, nine per cent achieved grade 7 to 9 in the subject.

Mike Yerosimou, head of school, said: "We couldn't be happier to announce that, following last week's excellent A-level results, we now have our best set of strong passes at GCSE ever.

"We've said for a long time that Epping St John's has limitless potential. The students deserve stable leadership and to be taught by the very best teachers. These results vindicate



our vision and give us confidence that this school is improving very quickly, becoming the exceptional educational establishment that Epping deserves."

A raft of improvements at the school to help students reach their potential have been praised by teenagers.

Oliver Warren, who achieved four grade 9 and five grade 8 in his exams, said: "I have done a lot of revision in my own time after school, but the school and teachers are such a great support network and the effort they put into study clubs and Saturday school helped massively."

James Cronin attended five study clubs every week to ensure he got the very best grades. The effort paid off and he collected one grade 8, three grade 7, four grade 6 and one grade 5. He said: "Not many schools offer study clubs like Epping St John's; our teachers really put in a lot of effort into our year group."



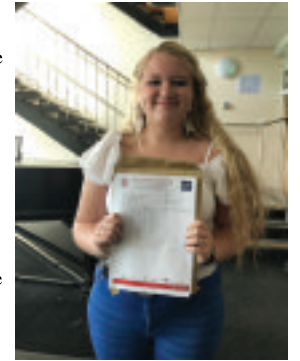


students to follow their dreams and pursue their chosen paths for further study at sixth-form, college or through apprenticeships.

hard to revise at home with the distractions."

Georgia Samuels achieved five grade 8, four grade 7 and a grade A. She said: "The extra revision sessions are so helpful. The teachers being there with us helped me to get better grades."

Amber Tapley achieved a Distinction, one grade 8, one grade 7, two grade 6, two grade 5, two grade B and one grade C. She said: "Saturday school and the extra revision sessions really helped. I had support from my teachers if I got stuck. I feel the school helped me a lot. It's my teachers who got me through it. I feel really relieved with these results."

Students and staff Burnt Mill Academy were celebrating as the summer's GCSE results were released.

More than half of Year 11 students at the school, in Harlow, achieved a standard pass of the old five or more A\* to C grades including English and maths.

A total of 71 per cent of students achieved a standard pass in English, while 67 per cent achieved the standard in maths, 68 per cent in science and 81 per cent in modern foreign languages.

Head of school Laura McGlashan said: "I am extremely proud of the students and their results. There are so many fantastic individual achievements which will allow our
